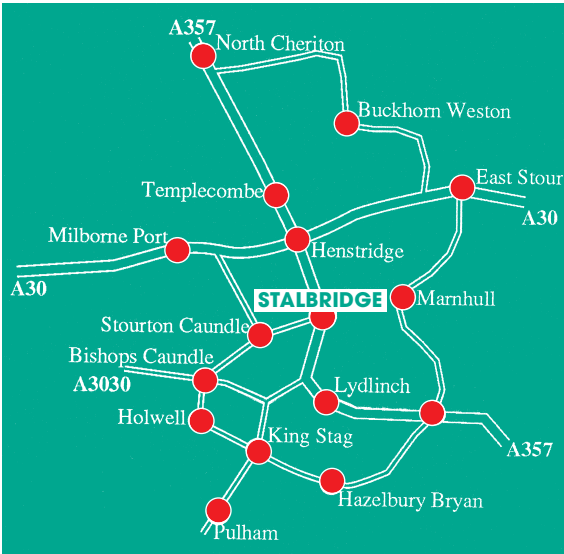

The Team of Health Professional Staff of Stalbridge Surgery

We have a team of 8 health professionals providing the medical care at Stalbridge Surgery. The team comprises of:

- 2 full time General Practitioners
- 3 Nurse Practitioner Specialists in General Practice
- 2 Practice Nurses
- 1 Health Care Assistant

Traditionally General Practice care has been provided solely by the Doctor and the Nurse. Medical Practice has evolved over recent years and this has seen the development of a number of different Health Care Professionals providing the traditional care of General Practice.

Nurse Practitioner Specialists in General Practice are still a relatively new phenomenon, although Nurse Practitioners have been active in hospital departments for some time. The Nurse Practitioner role is one that works both independently and alongside a traditional GP. Their training means they are fully experienced to independently consult with patients, examine, diagnose and action a plan of health care across a multitude of clinical situations.

The Practice Nurse role has expanded in recent times, their role of blood taking and simple dressings has evolved into more intricate and specialised care of chronic disease management of areas such as Diabetes, Asthma and Heart disease.

Health Care Assistants have been active in the NHS for many years but are relatively new to General Practice. Their role has evolved into the more practical aspect of care such as blood taking, ear syringing, investigative procedures such as an ECG or spirometry and simple immunisations for example influenza.

We feel that this team approach allows a timely and appropriate access to health care.

Dr Peter Furber joined Stalbridge as a full time General Practitioner in 2005.

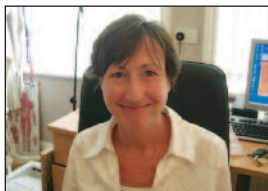
Prior to relocating to Dorset he had previously been a full time GP in Rothley, Leicestershire for 15 years.
